Policies and Procedures for 2008-09 TrueNote Year

- I. Classes begin September 2, 2008 and end May 25, 2009.
- II. Payments can be mailed to the address below and *please* include your child's name on the bottom of your check. A \$25 registration fee is due with the registration and is non-refundable. The registration fee covers the 2008-2009 school year and any additional siblings. - III. <u>Inclement Weather Policy:</u> Please read carefully. TrueNote Bands will observe the following closing policy: A. If the Wake County Schools close, our program will not meet.
